Bottles and jars must be empty.

- Heat resistant glass kitchenware
- Bulbs
- Mirror glass





Rigid plastics

- Plastic canisters
- Plastic bottles
- Tubs
- Trays

No thanks

- Soft plastics
- PVC (e.g. plastic tubing)

Plastic items must be empty, visibly clean and dry.





Metal

- Beverage cans
- Foil trays
- Food cans
- Aluminum foil

Items must be empty and scraped clean.





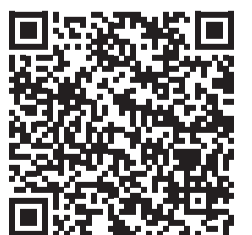
Food waste

- Bread and pastry leftovers
- Meat and fish leftovers, also bones
- Coffee grounds, tea leaves and filters
- Milk products
- Fruits and vegetables
- Rice and pasta
- Egg and nut shells
- Cut flowers

Please put all food waste in the green bag.

No thanks

- Packaging
- Cotton swabs and nappies
- Pizza boxes
- Soil
- Ashes and cigarette stumps
- Hygiene waste
- Aluminium foil
- Cat litter
- Garden waste





Residual waste

- Soiled paper and plastics
- Yoghurt pots
- Pizza boxes
- Soiled single-use packaging
- Nappies
- Sanitary towels
- Vacuum cleaner bags

Cardboard

- Cardboard boxes

Items must be dry and clean.

- Wet and soiled cardboard
- Books
- Pizza boxes
- Cardboard cups and other plastic laminated cardboard
- Food and beverage cartons





Food and beverage cartons

- Milk and yoghurt cartons
- Juice cartons
- Tomato or bean cartons
- Soup cartons

No thanks

- Pizza boxes
- Plastic laminated cardboard such as cardboard cups
- Coffee bags and crisps bags

Cartons must be empty and scraped clean if possible.





Soft plastics

- Plastic bags
- Plastic foil wrap
- Bubble wrap

No thanks

- Coffee bags and crisps bags
- PVC, e.g. rainwear and beach balls

Items must be empty and dry.



Grey box

Hazardous waste, Batteries, Small electronics, and Light bulbs



Hazardous waste

- Paint containers
- Spray cans
- Weed killer
- Chemicals, e.g. drain cleaner
- Hand sanitiser



Place items upright in the box.



Small light bulbs

- CFL bulbs
- LED bulbs
- Small fluorescent tubes



Collect in a plastic bag in the box.



Batteries from e.g.

- Hearing aids
- Toys
- Greeting cards



Collect in a plastic bag in the box.



Small electronics

- Mobile phones
- Electric toothbrushes
- Shavers
